

SMUD Residential Cool Roof Program Rebate Application and Authorization for Cool Roof Inspections

- (1) Rebate form must be submitted to SMUD **AFTER** the project is completed. Either the Contractor or the Residential Building Owner may submit the completed rebate application.
- (2) The Residential Building Owner must present to SMUD two (2) documents in order for an incentive payment to be processed: **the copy of the actual invoice AND the copy of permit** for this roofing project.

Residential Building Owner understands and agrees that SMUD is not a party to any cool roof installation contract entered into between Building Owner and Contractor, and Building Owner agrees to hold harmless SMUD for any and all liability, loss, cost, or damage of every kind, nature or description arising out of such a contract, or any SMUD on-site verification of the installation of a cool roof system and/or product. Building owner further understands that SMUD does not guarantee energy or bill savings as a result of the installation of this equipment.

Indemnity

Residential Building Owner shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the District, its directors, officers, agents, and employees against all claims, loss, damage, expense, and liability asserted or incurred by other parties, including, but not limited to District's employees, arising out of or in any way connected with the performance of this rebate program and excepting only such loss, damage, or liability as may be caused by the intentional acts or the sole negligence of the District.

Building Owner Signature requesting the payment of SMUD Incentive for this Project

Building Owner acknowledges that SMUD will make an incentive payment of 20¢ for flat roofs or 10¢ for steep roofs per square foot of the building area directly under the roof (excluding garage area, roof walls for the flat roofs, overhangs). The rebate payment shall go directly to the property owner for the installation of the Cool Roof products and/or system for the above referenced roofing project. Building Owner agrees to allow SMUD and its agents, upon request, reasonable access to the building roof for the post-installation cool roof inspections.
