

High-Efficiency Dishwasher Program

Get up to a \$50 Rebate!

You can receive a \$30 or \$50 rebate when you purchase an ultra high-efficiency dishwasher that exceeds the federal standard and ENERGY STAR® minimum Energy Factor ratings. To qualify for the dishwasher rebate, the water heater that provides water to the dishwasher must be electric.

Pick a Star, an ENERGY STAR®!

The ENERGY STAR® label helps consumers identify dishwashers and other products that save money and energy, and help the environment by using less natural resources. The ENERGY STAR® label is awarded to products meeting efficiency levels established by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Department of Energy.



Efficiency Rating

Dishwasher efficiency is measured by the Energy Factor (EF). The EF is the amount of energy it takes to heat the water to wash, and the amount of energy it takes to operate the machine. The current ENERGY STAR® specification includes an EF of .65. SMUD is offering rebates to customers who purchase ENERGY STAR®-qualified dishwashers at the highest efficiency levels.

Tier 1	0.65	339	\$30
Tier 2	0.68	325	\$50

SMUD will pay a \$30 rebate for Tier 1 dishwashers, \$50 on Compact dishwashers and \$50 rebate for Tier 2 dishwashers. To qualify for a rebate, the dishwasher must have an Energy Factor of .65 or higher and use 339 kWh/yr or less.

Rebate Eligibility Requirements

- Effective date of program is January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009 or until funding is depleted. Only purchases made on or after the start date will be eligible for the rebate.
- The purchased dishwasher must be on the SMUD list of qualified products.
- The water heater that provides water heating to the house or apartment must be electric.
- The dishwasher(s) must be purchased for primary use in a residence or business receiving SMUD electric service.
- Purchased dishwasher(s) must be new/undamaged and for personal use only, NOT FOR RESALE, or relocation outside of SMUD's service area.
- Rebate application must be received in SMUD's office within 60 days from the date of purchase or customer may forfeit all rebate allowances. Failure to provide forms and other documentation may result in the customer's ineligibility for SMUD's Dishwasher Program, including but not limited to all rebates.

Participation Information

- Rebates are subject to change and/or discontinuation. Call 1-888-742-SMUD (7683) to obtain current information.
- Each customer can only receive one rebate per address, per year.
- SMUD reserves the right to inspect installation premises or request additional information/documentation prior to rebate payment.
