Get a \$100 rebate when you purchase an ENERGY STAR® qualified refrigerator with an efficiency rating that exceeds the July 1, 2001 Federal Appliance Standard by 25%.

Cut your refrigerator operating costs in half.

Your refrigerator operates 24 hours a day and uses the most electricity of all your kitchen appliances. An old refrigerator can account for up to one-third of your home's total energy usage. The older the refrigerator, the more electricity it uses. If your present refrigerator is 10 years old or older, you'll save energy and money when you replace it with a new, more efficient unit. New models can be as much as 50% more energy-efficient than older refrigerators.

Energy Efficiency is the best buy.

Over the past two decades, the efficiency of refrigerators has improved dramatically. Manufacturers incorporate advanced features such as better insulation, more efficient compressors, improved heat transfer surfaces and more precise temperature and defrost mechanisms to make more energy-efficient refrigerators.

Although an energy-efficient refrigerator may be more expensive to purchase than a less efficient refrigerator, the energy-efficient model will cost you less to operate over the lifetime of the appliance. The energy savings for an energy-efficient model could pay for itself in as little as three years. Over the 15-year average lifetime of a new energy-efficient refrigerator, you could save hundreds of dollars.

The ENERGY STAR® label helps consumers identify refrigerators and other products that save money and energy, and help the environment by using less natural resources. The ENERGY STAR® label is awarded to products meeting efficiency levels established by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Department of Energy.

It is the national label for energy efficiency.

Look for the ENERGY STAR® label displayed on qualifying refrigerators at participating dealers. Ask the sales representative for a SMUD mail-in rebate form with your new refrigerator purchase.

Rebate Eligibility Requirements

- Effective date of program is January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009 or earlier due to funding availability. Only purchases made on or after January 1, 2009 will be eligible for the rebate.
- The refrigerator must exceed 2001 Federal Appliance Standards by a minimum of 25%.
- The refrigerator(s) must be purchased for primary use in a residence or business receiving SMUD electric service.
- Customers, out-of-town owners, or property management companies purchasing refrigerators for multiple-use buildings are **limited to the total number of units within the specific building(s)**. When this number is reached, this location will not be eligible for further participation for a period of three years.
- Purchased refrigerator(s) must be new/undamaged and for personal use only, NOT FOR RESALE, or relocation outside of SMUD's service area.
- Rebate application must be received in SMUD's office within 60 days from the date of purchase or customer may forfeit all rebate allowances. Failure to provide forms and other documentation may result in the customer's ineligibility for SMUD's Refrigerator Program, including but not limited to all rebates.

Participation Information

- Rebates are subject to change and/or discontinuation. Call 1-888-742-7683 to obtain current information.
- Single refrigerator purchase - each customer can only receive one rebate, per address, every three years.
- Multiple refrigerator purchases - each customer can only receive one rebate, for each apartment or unit, every three years.
- SMUD reserves the right to inspect installation premises or request additional information/documentation prior to rebate payment.
