SMUD hosts climate change speaker

The Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) will host “Polar Meltdown: A Climate Change Science Update,” a lecture and photo survey by Robert Christopherson, professor emeritus of geography, American River College on Wednesday, April 23, 2008 from noon to 1:00 p.m.

Professor Christopherson will present an overview of climate change science and the latest Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) scientific report summaries – all illustrated with current images, photos and graphics. Christopherson is the author of the leading physical geography textbooks used in the United States and Canada. He has visited the Arctic and Antarctic region nine times in the last five years gathering material for his award-winning books. Christopherson has spoken at hundreds of colleges, community and professional groups across the United States and Canada.

The presentation will be held at the SMUD Headquarters Building, 6201 S Street, Sacramento, and is free to the public.
