

Three Categories of Metrics defined by the WSAB:

- Progress Metrics that are designed to track concrete actions toward reducing wildfire risk. Progress metrics include absolute metrics (e.g., number of grid condition findings per circuit mile). We have identified seven progress metrics for Pole Clearing Area (PCA) and High Fire Threat District Tiers 1 & 2 focus areas.
- Program targets that outline utility progress toward the utility's own specific targets
 identified in their WMP. We have identified four program targets.
- Outcome metrics that track wildfire and planned de-energization related outcomes on impacted communities. Outcome metrics include leading and lagging indicators of wildfire and de-energization risk and while they describe utility risk reduction. We have identified five outcome metrics, collected during fire season and inside the PCA.
