Competition Contract Awards

- 2021 year to date totals:
 - \$208M contract awards
 - 65% were competitively awarded \$135M total
- Majority of direct procurement (\$51M) for pole replacement services in Q2 2021
- Q3 2021: 88% competitively awarded contract awards – \$43.8M total



Participation & Completion

- In Q3 2021, there were 24 events with an average of 3.8 bidders, an increase from 2.7 in Q2
- We are currently exceeding our target of 3 or more bidders per event
- 2021 year to date totals:
 - 87 solicitation events
 - 3.5 bidders on average





Supplier Education & Economic Development (SEED) Participation

- Through Q3 2021, SEED participation was 20.4%, exceeding our goal of 20% – \$35.5M total
- Q3 was a strong quarter, with 26.6% participation \$6.5M total
- 2021 year to date totals:
 - \$6M professional services
 - \$6M materials
 - \$20M construction
 - \$3M technology





Supplier Education & Economic Development (SEED) Compliance Reporting

SEED Contracts

- Since 2015, SMUD has closed 48 SEED contracts with 92.5% compliance to date
- 2 contracts ended in Q3:

4Leaf

- 2018 contract; 3 years; construction inspection services
- Committed to 20% SEED participation
- Achieved 13% SEED

TRC

- 2018 contract; 3 years; geotechnical engineering
- Committed to 20% SEED participation
- Achieved 11% SEED
- SMUD continues to increase oversight of SEED contracts
