Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP)



SMUD's priority is delivering safe, reliable, sustainable and economic electric service



Minimize the probability that SMUD's transmission and distribution (T&D) system may be the origin or contributing source for the ignition of a wildfire.



Implement a WMP that embraces safety, prevention, mitigation and recovery as a central priority for SMUD.



Implement a WMP that is consistent with state law and objectives.
