NCGA No. 1 & NCEA

Northern California Gas Authority Number 1 (NCGA No. 1)

- Created in 2007 as joint powers agency for a prepaid gas transactions in support of commodity purchases
- Board approves debt service and approves payments of \$30 million

Northern California Energy Authority (NCEA)

- Created in 2018 as joint powers agency for a prepaid commodity (gas and power) transactions in support of commodity purchases
- Board approves debt service and approves payments of \$33 million
