




Option of Electronic Elections (Item 1)

LAFCo and Special Districts have the option of completing the election of special district representatives via email. Does your district approve of LAFCo distributing electronic ballots to districts that wish to receive them in the future?

A "Yes" vote means SMUD authorizes LAFCo to send out ballots via email to those special districts who choose to vote electronically in future elections.

A "No" vote means LAFCo should continue to distribute paper ballots to all districts and distribute them via certified mail.





Option of Electronic Elections (Item 2)

If so, in the future does your district prefer to receive its ballot via email and submit its vote electronically (via fax, email or scanned ballot)?

A "Yes" vote means SMUD wishes to receive electronic ballots in future elections and have the option to return its ballot in an electronic format (email, fax or scanned ballot).

A "No" vote means SMUD prefers to continue to receive and submit paper ballots.
