- SMUD seeks to establish five-year contract with EATON for the supply of network protectors.
- SMUD expects higher than historical levels of network protector spend.
- Eaton is the only SMUD-approved manufacturer meeting minimum requirements.
- Support SMUD's transition from live-front to dead-front network protectors.
- Maintain reliability and efficiency of SMUD's electrical distribution system.



Safety

Transition to Dead-Front Network Protectors:

- Live-front models have exposed energized parts, posing safety risks.
- Dead-front models have inaccessible energized parts, improving personnel safety.
