### **Background**

- SMUD uses natural gas storage for 3 key benefits:
  - Reliability: Fueling our power plants during system constraints
  - Flexibility: Avoiding penalties during abnormal operating conditions
  - Arbitrage: Maintaining stable commodity costs



#### Context

- SMUD has two contracts for storage with two different storage providers
- One contract is expiring on March 31, 2026
- Bids were received from three Northern California storage providers
- Staff conducted an evaluation of the offers and determined that the Central Valley Gas Storage offer provided superior value vs. alternatives

- ~1,000,000 Dth of inventory (equivalent to 1 Billion cubic feet)
- Injection rate: 10,000 Dth/day
- Withdrawal rate: 20,000 Dth/day
