IT Master Agreements Introduction

- Staff has qualified a pool of contractors that will have the opportunity to bid on future tasks
- Replace the existing IT Master Services Agreements (IT-MSA) previously established in 2016
- Prior to establishing the IT-MSA, staff was required to issue separate solicitations
- This strategy has significantly reduced the amount of time and effort to onboard resources to support IT operations and project initiatives



IT Master Agreements Scope of services

- IT infrastructure investment, Zero Carbon plan, and community impact projects
- Supports ongoing need for IT support resources
- Scope of work will be on a task-by-task basis
- Contractors who are successful at the task level will be awarded a contract

Types of IT Support:

- SAP Administrators
- Software Developers
- Technology Analysts
- Software Automation Testers
- Enterprise Architecture Analysts



IT Master Agreements Procurement strategy

IT-MSA (prior RFP)

- Request for proposals
- Focused on 4 specific categories
- Technical requirements required a burdensome evaluation process
- Significant time to negotiate master service agreement terms

IT Master Agreements (current RFQ)

- Request for qualifications
- Enables all areas of IT support work
- 3 simple mandatory requirements
- Price negotiated on a task-by-task basis
- Pass fail qualification will allow for the addition of contractors over time
