We're hosting the Emerging Leaders Energy Summit to empower you with knowledge and tools to address sustainability challenges. This year's theme, Fueling the Future – Where food meets energy, highlights the connection between sustainability efforts in energy and food. The Summit aims to amplify your voice and actions in shaping a cleaner, healthier and sustainable future for our communities.

## September

Friday, Sept. 12 - Applications are due at smud.org/EnergySummit

A team must consist of 2-6 members, either high school juniors and seniors or post-secondary students, including those from colleges, trade schools and community organizations. There will be 2 different tracks – high school and post-secondary. Each student must submit an application that's approved and signed by a legal guardian if they're under 18. No late or substitute applications will be accepted.

All registered students will receive a digital welcome packet with the event agenda and links to information from our community partners.

Teams will design and implement a community service project for their school or community based on the Summit theme. This project may also fulfill your school's community service project requirement.

## October

**Friday, Oct. 10 -** Teams check in with the event coordinator by submitting a video of less than 2 minutes describing the theme, concept and nature of their project. The link to the video is posted publicly to YouTube and sent to the event coordinator.

**Saturday, Oct. 25** - Students are invited to attend an in-person, Night at the Museum, at SMUD Museum of Science and Curiosity (MOSAC), where they can explore and network with other participants.

### **November**

**Friday, Nov. 21** - Teams will complete a short progress survey of their project and students will have the opportunity to meet with event coordinators to ask questions and receive detailed updates.

## **January**

**Saturday, Jan. 17, 2026 -** Teams participate in community poster sessions and present to judges.

**Stuff We All Get (SWAG):** Participants who complete objectives will receive SWAG like an event t-shirt, messenger bag, water bottle and more.

**Scholarships:** Scholarships of \$2,000 in various categories are awarded to the top 4 teams. Community and industry partners may distribute additional prizes or awards.
