Solar and Storage Rate

If you have qualifying renewable generation—such as a photovoltaic system—installed at your business, this option is for you. The renewable generation supplies your business' electricity needs, which in turn reduces the electricity supplied by SMUD. Intermittent excess energy produced by the renewable energy system is sent back to SMUD and is reflected as a credit on your bill.

Clear space

You must leave 8 feet of clearance in front of SMUD's green electrical boxes. This helps us work more efficiently, especially during a power outage. You may be charged if SMUD has to clear the space. You must also allow access to utility easements on your property so we can inspect and maintain our power lines and equipment.

Power theft

Our technicians encounter various methods of power theft each month. Unsafe conditions are a danger to all SMUD customers. Please report any unsafe situation you discover by calling us at **916-732-6594**.

Other services & rate options

Agricultural Time-of-Day (TOD) Rates

Agricultural TOD rate options may be beneficial for customers who can adjust their energy usage to off-peak hours.

Economic development

An economic development program is available to qualifying commercial customers locating, expanding, or retaining business in our service territory with a maximum demand of at least 300 kW. Incentives will apply to the System Infrastructure Fixed Charge, Site Infrastructure Charge, Summer Peak Demand Charge and electricity usage charges on their bill. There is a larger discount for locating in a Disadvantaged Community.

Energy efficiency and gas-to-electric incentives

SMUD offers a variety of incentives for approved energy and gas-to-electric equipment upgrades.

Power factor adjustment

Customers with power factors below 95% may incur additional charges on their monthly bill. Customers may benefit from establishing a contract to pay a monthly waiver instead of the power factor adjustment.

Energy Assistance Program Rate (EAPR)

This is SMUD's discounted rate for certified nonprofit agencies whose primary function is to provide sleeping quarters for low-income residents.

Your rate classification

As your community-owned, not-for-profit electric service, SMUD proudly provides rates that average between 43 to 57% lower than neighboring PG&E as of June 1, 2022. These rates are for commercial, industrial, agricultural and lighting customers. To continually provide our customers with competitive pricing, our electric rates and options are extensive. This document summarizes these rates and options.



Information about your rates

Effective July 1, 2008, a hydro-generation surcharge was implemented. It adjusts annually, as needed, based on precipitation.

Commercial & Industrial Time-of-Day

Time-of-Day (TOD) rates price energy consumption (kWh) by seasonal peak and off-peak time periods, including an "off-peak saver" period during non-summer months. These rates include a System Infrastructure Fixed Charge, a Site Infrastructure Charge (based on the highest 12-month demand), a Summer Peak Demand Charge and a Maximum Demand Charge (based on highest monthly demand).

Lighting rates

Street Lighting Service

The following street lighting rate schedules apply to streets, highways, bridges, public parks, elementary schools, secondary schools and colleges.

SL_COM	Customer owned & maintained
SL_CODM	Customer owned, SMUD maintained (closed)
SL_DOM	SMUD owned & maintained
SL_COM_M	Customer owned & maintained, metered

Outdoor Lighting Service

Rate Category NLGT

Applies to SMUD owned and maintained outdoor overhead lighting service (dusk-to-dawn night lights) for customers not covered under Street Lighting Service, Rate Schedule SLS.

Traffic Signal Service

Rate Category SL_TSF

Closed to new customers.

Traffic Control

Intersection Light Service

Rate Category TS_F, TS

Applies to pedestrian and vehicular traffic signal units. The related control devices and associated intersection lighting equipment are owned and maintained by the customer.
