- Battery-operated radio


- Fresh drinking water

We get power from many sources, including hydropower, solar, wind, geothermal and natural gas generation plants. Our goal is a balanced and sustainable mix of power and we're always adding to our clean energy sources. In 2024, our power was 62% carbon free. The amount of carbon-free energy can change from year to year based on several factors, particularly the weather, which drives the amount of hydro energy we can

generate. Through our 2030 Zero Carbon Plan, we're working to eliminate 100% of carbon emissions from our power supply by 2030, while maintaining reliability and keeping our rates among the lowest in California.

#### Rate changes

SMUD's rates will increase for business and residential customers by 3% on Jan. 1, 2026, as approved by our Board in 2025. Our rates remain among the lowest in California and on average more than 50% lower than our neighboring investor-owned utility.
