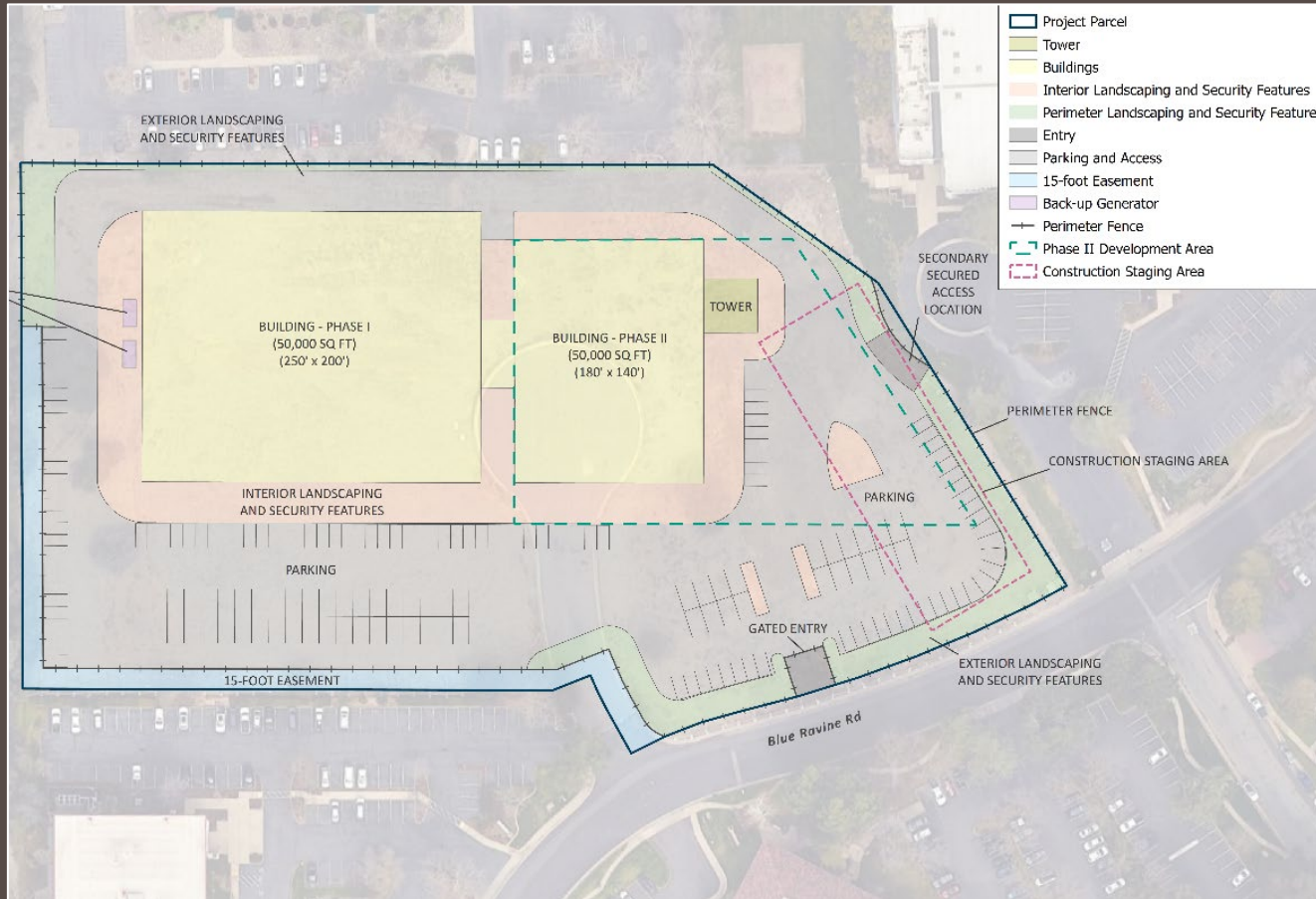

- Administrative operations building
- Up to 100,000 sq. ft.
- 100-foot-high communications tower
- 2 development phases
  - Phase 1: 50k sq. ft. and communications tower
  - Phase 2: 50k sq. ft.
- Access off of Woodmere Road
- Total 40 employees

# Environmental Analysis

Prepared an Initial Study and Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND)

Potentially significant impacts reduced to less-than-significant levels with mitigation measures related to:

- Air Quality
- Biological Resources
- Cultural Resources
- Tribal Cultural Resources
- Utilities and Service Systems

# Public Review Process

- Notice of Intent and Draft MND released for 30-day public comment period on July 23, 2024
- Published at SMUD.org, Sacramento Bee, and State Clearinghouse
- Notices mailed to property owners and customers within 1,000 feet of the project
- Documents available at SMUD Customer Service Center and East Campus Operations Center and at [smud.org/CEQA](https://smud.org/CEQA)
- Online public meeting held on August 8, 2024
- Two comment letters from Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (CVRWQCB) and Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District (SMAQMD); one commentary email from a Folsom resident
- Final MND posted on September 19, 2024

# SMUD Board Process

- Initial outreach on November 22, 2023
- Tribes Contacted:
  - Lone Band of Miwok Indians
  - Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians
  - United Auburn Indian Community (UAIC)
  - Wilton Rancheria
- Lone and UAIC responded with no identified issues
- No AB 52 consultation was requested
