Smart Homes Program Requirements

Incentives are only available to the participating builder for homes that are built in SMUD service territory.

Participating projects must meet minimum program requirements for all homes within the same project, built after the date this Application is submitted. A home is considered built or complete when a CF-3R compliance form is uploaded to a registry approved by the California Energy Commission.

All-electric single family homes or multifamily homes must:

- Meet building code
- Have no natural gas connection on-site
- Builder shall provide adequate space for all the electric infrastructure and equipment necessary to serve the development

Homes must include:

- Electric vehicle (EV) infrastructure pre-wiring and plug for single family homes
- Segregated circuits for energy monitoring readiness for single family and multifamily homes
- Heat pump water and space heating
- Builders agree to include communicating smart thermostats designed to meet ENERGY STAR® certification

How to Participate

The Smart Homes application and incentive process can be completed in three steps:

- 1. Submit application
- 2. Project completes technical review to verify the project meets program requirements.
- 2. Receive acceptance package: Letter and additional enrollment document from SMUD confirming application and project submittal is complete and satisfactory. Incentives are officially reserved upon issuance of the letter.
- 3. Submit Incentive Request form: Form that informs SMUD of a completed project and initiates an incentive payment.

 5) HERS registry sharing by your HERS rater: For CHEERS: Please add "TRC Energy Solutions" to the project member team If the project is a custom home, let us know who is listed as the "builder"
