Native plants are adapted to their local climates and the soil characteristics of specific locations. In California, planting natives can save water, help pollinators and make your garden more resilient to the extremes of climate change.

It's important to plant locally adapted natives, because natives to California's coastal, desert or mountain regions may struggle here.
